

Walking in Massachusetts



Daniel Webster Wildlife Sanctuary, Marshfield, MA

Special tips for this location:

- The sanctuary is open daily from dawn to dusk, and while admission is free, donations are appreciated.
- Parking is available at the end of Winslow Cemetery Road, with approximately 12 spots.
- Please be cautious after rainfall, as the boardwalks can be slippery.

Highlights: This is an ideal spot for birders, boardwalk enthusiasts, and wildflower lovers! There are about 3 miles of trails in total, including a 0.6-mile roundtrip accessible trail leading to a wildlife observation blind.

Hike idea:

- Start at the entry buildings and take a large loop around the sanctuary, exploring any side trails that pique your interest.
- Stay right on Pond Trail, then turn right onto Secret Trail.
- Take a right onto Fox Hill Trail and continue onto the River Walk Boardwalk.
- When the boardwalk ends, take another right on Fox Hill and be sure to check out Piggery Loop on your way back to the car!

Pets are not allowed, so please leave all animals at home.
